REVIEW SCOPE

- End-to-end execution flow across procurement, governance and business interfaces
- Focus on where momentum breaks between strategy and daily execution
- Review depth is cross-functional and architecture-oriented

WHAT THE REVIEW SURFACED

- The system is strong in expertise but weak in orchestration
- Interfaces between functions create avoidable delay
- Leadership intent is not translated into explicit ownership and decision logic
- Technology is partially digitizing confusion instead of removing friction

KEY ARCHITECTURE GAPS

- No end-to-end owner across the critical business flow
- Escalation paths are clearer than decision paths
- Governance forums exist, but execution accountability is not anchored
- Interventions are fragmented instead of sequenced
